About Girls Rise Up

Our mission is to empower girls to achieve their full potential. Through capacity building and coaching, we help girls to become change makers, supporting them to make opportunities that create lasting change for themselves and their communities. We are building a network of confident and resilient girls and equipping them with the skills needed to take the lead. By supporting girls into employment, education and training we want to improve their life trajectory.

The project – Raised Voices (part of our Powered By Girls Programme)

Our Powered By Girls Programme aims to support girls aged 16 - 24 girls in London to gain key skills to help them take and make opportunities. Raised Voices is a new area of our programme that aims to give girls a platform to use their voices to make change on issues that matter to them. This creative, photography or film-based project will provide girls with key skills in creative media, a platform for talking about the issues that matter to them and will create case studies of their experiences as girls living in London.

Our girls have decided to focus on 'The Sexualisation of girls' for their work over the next year. This project will help them to develop a creative campaign piece to help them raise awareness of the issue. Raised Voices aims not only to provide girls with the opportunity to create something, but to help them develop key skills that may help them to gain access to the creative industry.

We are looking for a Creative Youth Facilitator to deliver this project and support the girls by running workshops and leading them through the process of creating campaign materials (film, animation etc). We hope the sessions will cover the creative process of designing and developing a campaign asset and will arm the girls with practical knowledge of these creative pathways. We aim to help build confidence - helping them to raise their voices on issues that matter to them and to increase their skillset. The project will be delivered across 3-4 months, with training-based sessions and delivery. The end result will be a creative media piece that can be used to help raise awareness for the girls campaign which is based on combatting the Sexualisation of girls.

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The role:

- Design and deliver sessions to help our girls to create an asset for their campaign. The sessions must also teach the girls new skills in a creative area such as video, photography or animation etc
- The aim is to run 3-4 sessions aimed at taking the girls on a journey of campaign asset creation, learning on the way.
- Completion/editing of final project piece

Experience

- Creative expertise in either video, photo, animation or illustration (or other creative medium)
- Sound knowledge of participatory approaches to youth engagement
- Good judgment and safeguarding knowledge
- Ability to create and support the development of campaign assets that have impact and help generate change

Timeframe and Budget

The work will need to begin in November 2021 and will be completed by March 2022, assuming 1 session per month over a 4-month period. Please note the first session is to take place on **20th November 2021**.

The maximum fee for this contract is £3000 (inclusive of VAT if applicable). We anticipate that this piece of work will take approximately 4 days total and any editing work will need to be completed within this budget and timeframe. The project will take place in London . Girls Rise Up will pay for any associated travel directly related to the project.

Skills and Qualifications

Consultant would need to have:

- Experience of working directly with young people
- An ability to support the meaningful engagement of young people in the creation of a campaign asset, ensuring it is led by them
- A commitment to UK girls' rights, displaying an understanding of the challenges and issues facing young women that may be themes to be explored during the project
- An ability to design workshops to meet the needs of young people and meet the projects aims
- A clear DBS (a DBS check can be arranged through Girls Rise Up)

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Safeguarding & Child protection

UK Data Protection law and Child Protection legislation must be adhered to at all times. In addition, Girls Rise Up has its own child protection policies that must be adhered to.

The consultant will be expected to sign and abide by Girls Rise Up's child protection policy. As this role involves direct engagement with young people, the consultant must be DBS checked (Disclosure and Barring Service). This can be arranged by Girls Rise Up before any engagement with young people commences.

All hard and digital copies must be returned at the end of the contract. All programme material remains the property of Girls Rise Up and the consultant may not use those materials in any other youth groups or programmes without the express written permission of Girls Rise Up.

How to apply

Girls Rise Up welcomes a response to these Terms of Reference from individuals or teams.

Applications should include:

1. A short statement with the consultants suggested approach
2. Example of similar work
3. A CV highlighting relevant experience
4. Proposed budget and timeline along with any other expenses you may incur. Please note there is a separate budget to cover the renting of space and equipment needed for this work.

The full application may be sent via email by midnight on **Friday 24th October 2021**

Applications will be judged on the above criteria by our girls and wider team.
